


## Display Board (a summary of your project)

# Suggested layout for display board

#### Left Side:

- I. Problem
- 2. Hypothesis / Aim
- 3. Background information

#### Middle:

- 4. Large title (Font size 150) (same as submitted on entry to Regional and National Finals)
- 5. Name and grade underneath the title
- 6. Method, including variables
- 7. Results include tables and graphs

### **Right Side:**

- 8. Analysis/discussion and Interpretation of results
- 9. Conclusion
- 10. Acknowledgements

Your poster is the most important part of your project. Your poster should be easy to read and understand. It should explain what you did, how you did it and what you found out. Make your poster eye-catching and interesting. You want visitors at Expo to stop and read about what you did. Summarised information must be laid out in a logical order. Anyone who wants more information, can read your report. (Your report is very important).
